FASA hosts IFE 2010 in Joburg

Likewise, through all the economic recessions, franchising has stood its ground and continues to be the first entrepreneurial stone thrown that causes the ripple effect in business innovation."

With just over 12% of business activity going through the franchise route at present compared to over 50% in the US, the potential for increased franchise growth remains high and shows like IFE aim to provide an ideal platform for prospective franchisees to find out more about this business format. When there is insecurity in the job market, or when retrenchments or retirements happen, people are spurred into being entrepreneurial, fully aware that they have to consider alternative careers. The opportunity of going into business suddenly becomes feasible and it is here that franchising comes into its own.

Says Thulani Cele, chairman of FASA, "South Africa has many entrepreneurs who have the drive and finance to start their own businesses but who do not give enough consideration to franchising as a route to diversify and achieve their ambitions. We appeal to business entrepreneurs who believe they have a good concept or who have an existing business they wish to expand, to consider franchising and to become part of this growing business sector."
