Jose Cuervo Black is aged in charred white American oak barrels for 18 months which softens the agave notes and introduces consumers to fuller-bodied Tequila reminiscent of aged bourbon. Its time in the barrels imparts a deep amber hue to the liquid and aromas of toasted oak, cinnamon, red apple, cocoa and coffee. The taste is thus slightly sweeter than you'd expect but without distracting from the subtle agave notes associated with Tequila. The finish is warm and smooth.

Jose Cuervo Black can still be enjoyed as a shot, of course, but it's infinitely better suited to slow sipping over rocks, or even with a mixer. "Jose Cuervo Black has an edge that comes with age, with a twist of untamed youth that will never be lost," says Joubert.
