

10 simple ways to grow your Facebook Page

1. Suggest to Friends

Just below your fanpage picture you'll find a link that says "Suggest to Friends". This allows you to invite all of your friends on Facebook. Unfortunately, in the "Suggest to Friends" window Facebook hasn't allowed a "Select All" feature. This is because the social network giant is trying to limit spamming and hopes that you will only select people that would have an interest in joining.
