Manny Montana (*Breakout Kings*) and Kick Gurry (*Speed Racer*) are also attached and will play FBI Agent Frank Parker and former cybercriminal turned good-guy Chase 'Rabbit' Rosen respectively. Award-winning director Diego Velasco (*The Zero Hour*) has also signed on to bring the story, written by Miles Chapman (*The Tomb*), to life.
