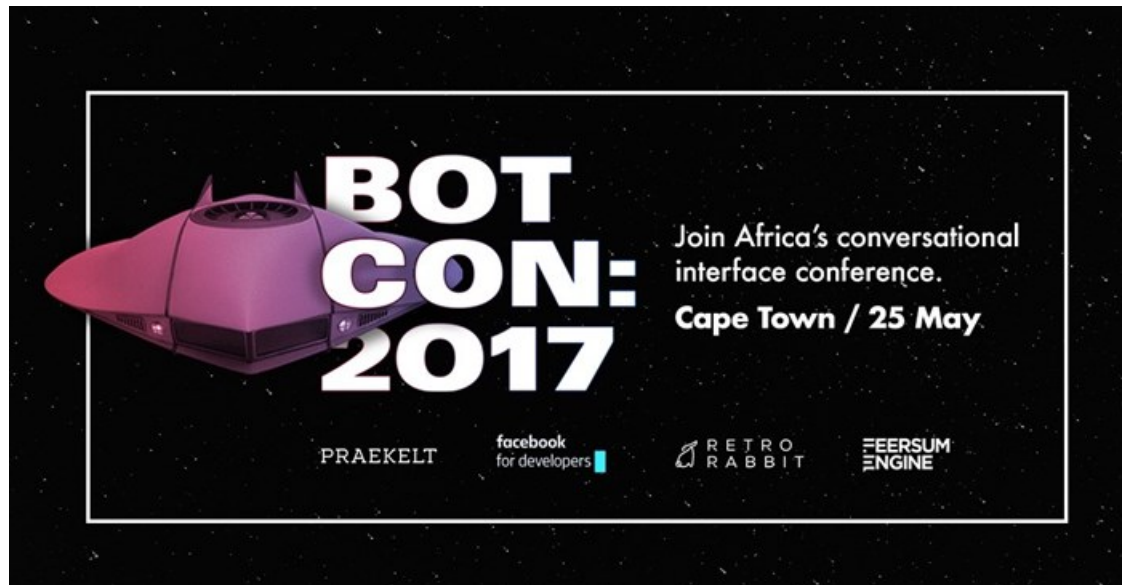


Book your spot for BotCon Africa 2017!
