

Air Seychelles launches new daily Johannesburg flights

Air Seychelles has launched a new daily service between the Seychelles and Johannesburg. Flight HM061 from Seychelles, operated by the airline's Airbus A320 aircraft departed the Seychelles International Airport under the command of captain Archille Young and first officer Bertrand Mein.

The round trip service will depart O.R. Tambo International Airport at 1.45pm and will arrive in the Seychelles at 8.40pm.
