Jeremy Loops will present his inaugural Summersault Festival at the Zevenwacht Wine Estate in Stellenbosch on 21 April. In addition to Loop, the lineup comprises of UK's electronica pop artist Youngr, Australia's folk artist Kim Churchill, indie folk sensation Matthew Mole, Cape Town musos Diamond Thug and the talented Sean Koch as well as indie-pop hybrid band World of Birds.

Loops jumped at the opportunity to create his own festival and bring some of his friends from around the world together on stage at a one-day festival in his hometown. Through his travels and tour locations, he has had the privilege of meeting some incredible artists along the way. He also wanted fellow South Africans in on this signature event.
