The judges also recognised Glenfiddich 21YO, Glenfiddich 14 YO Bourbon Barrel Reserve, The Balvenie Thirty and Glenfiddich 40 YO with each receiving a 'gold outstanding' medal. The company won 20 gold medals for Glenfiddich, The Balvenie and Grant's, winning 60 medals overall.
