

# Dan Patlansky chats new album

Dan Patlansky recently released his ninth studio album titled *PERFECTION KILLS*. We swung a few questions to the guitar god to find out more about this raw, honest and bluesy album.

## ■ **Can you tell us a about the recording process?**

We spent 10 days in studio tracking. Drums, bass, and most guitars were recorded live to capture a certain feel. We spent the rest of the time doing vocals and overdubs. I tried to keep it as natural as I could.



## ■ **What was it like producing the album yourself?**

Scary, because it's been some time since I've done this. Its also tough being objective when you are prodicing yourself, but I got into the swing of things and trust my gut feel for the most part on what I was hearing. I'm very happy with the album and had a great time getting my production ideas across.

## ■ **If you had to describe this album as a meal, what would it be and why?**

Meat and potatoes with a delicate sauce on top. The core of the album is raw and real, but garnished harmonically.

■ ***What's your favourite track and why?***

Johnny is my favourite, hence why it's the opening track. I feel this song captures how I want to come across musically.

■ ***How does this album differ from previous releases?***

I think it's a raw, more organic version of previous releases – the focus is still heavily on songs. It's just the way those songs are presented to the listener that differs.

■ ***What's your guilty pleasure when it comes to music?***

I don't really feel guilty about anything I listen to. I like a whole host of music and don't mind being judged by others if they disagree.
