After an epic and well documented 45-year career that launched an era of rock n roll legends, KISS launched their final ever tour in 2019.



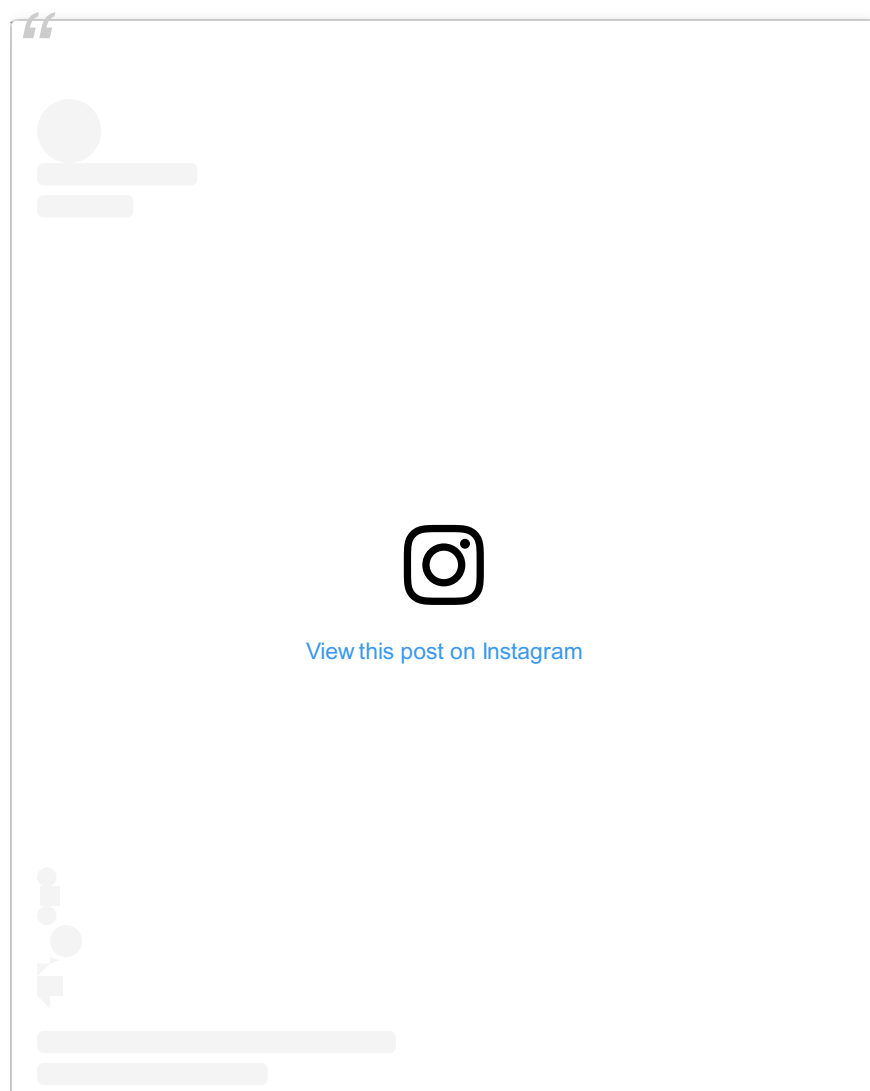
