

Idea Conference to be held in Pretoria

The biannual Idea Conference will celebrate South African creativity on 23 and 24 May, 2013, at the Brooklyn Theatre in Pretoria. The event is an opportunity for designers, built environment professionals and creative-minded individuals to be inspired by leading South African creative talent.



Conference hosts, the Pretoria Institute for Architecture (PIA), said that this will be a memorable event covering topics from diverse creative fields, such as: art, advertising, architecture, interior design, brand design, graphic design, illustration, filmmaking, industrial design, fashion, trend forecasting and textile design.
