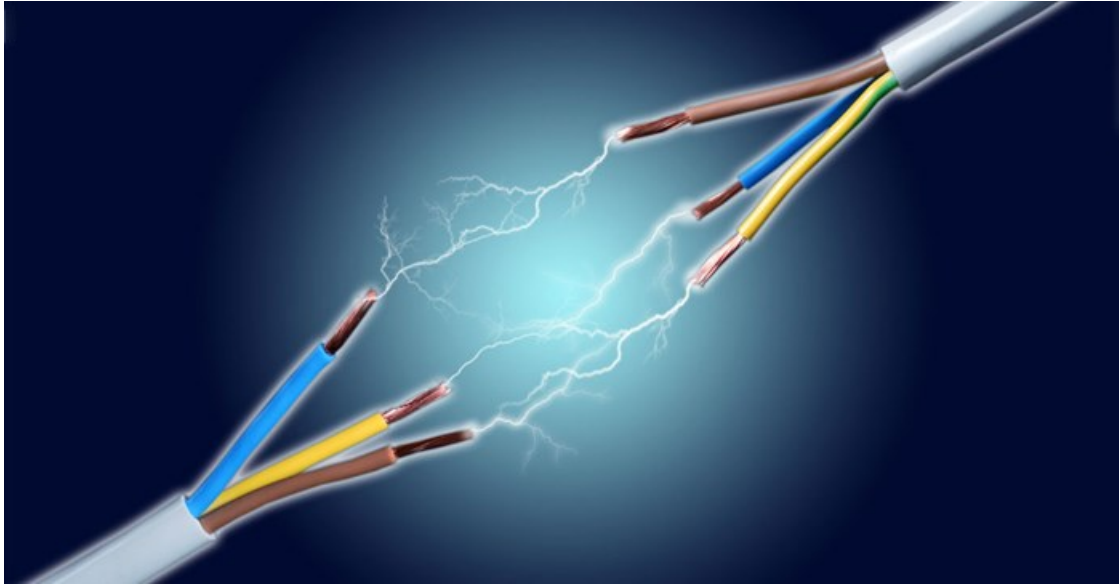


# POWER-GEN Africa announces launch of matchmaking tool
