Cape Town. I was born in Stellenbosch, and currently, live in Somerset West.


## 2. What's your claim to fame?

#### 9. List a few pain points the industry can improve on.


It will change from person to person, but I think personally, it's the mentality of the people in it. I always believe there's a place in this world for us all to shine.


Additionally, I use my NLP life coach qualification to guide clients to reach their ideals and steer them in the right direction for overall life success.

### 13. What's your secret talent/party trick?


I literally am the only person in the world who doesn't have a party trick, but my talent is I can sing.
